To whom it may concern,

Dear Sir/Madam,

Budavár Tours Travel Agency has inquired about the airport procedures as well as the entry requirements of Hungarian nationals to North Cyprus (Ercan Airport) during the upcoming summer period.

This is to inform you that all EU citizens are eligible to enter the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus(TRNC) without a visa. Futhermore a valid passport or identity card is sufficient to enter the country.

Charter flights, number FHY544 / FHY543, operated by Budavár Tours and Taurus Reisen have to make a stopover in Antalya, which is inevitable due to the known political reasons. In Turkey(Antalya) the passengers will stay in the aircraft for a short while, without any boarding or leaving the aircraft, and then the aircraft will continue on its given flight to its end destination namely North Cyprus. The return flight will occur in the same manner as described above.

Our Tourism Board have several references to the flights running on the same route. For many years, a number of charters have arrived at Ercan airport (ERC) from many member states of the European Union (England, Germany, Netherlands, etc.) in this way, whereby all the passengers travelled and entered North Cyprus on their ID Cards.

This is also to inform you that the website operating under the name "www.nctohungary.com" is a private website which has no official connection with the North Cyprus Tourism Organisation or any official authority of the TRNC.

In light of the above, it will be highly appreciated if the passangers of the mentioned flights, are allowed to check-in and board the aircraft on their ID-Cards.
